



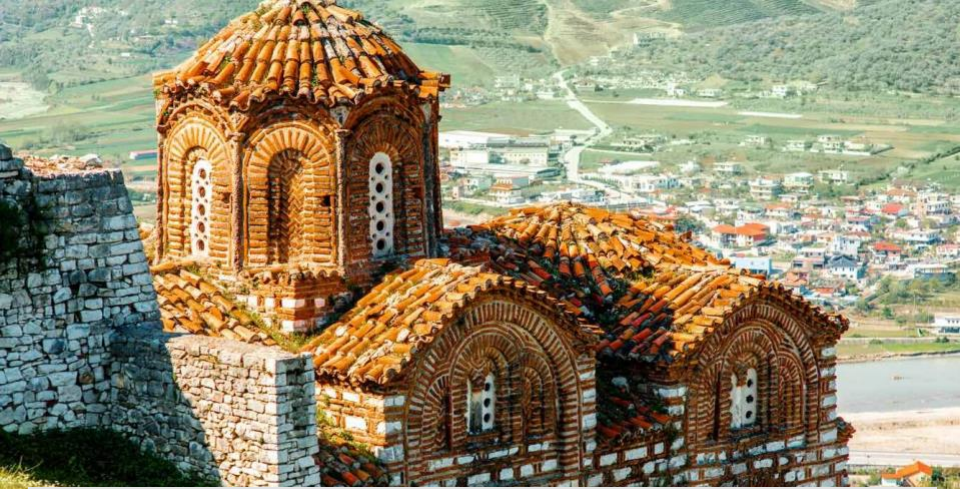

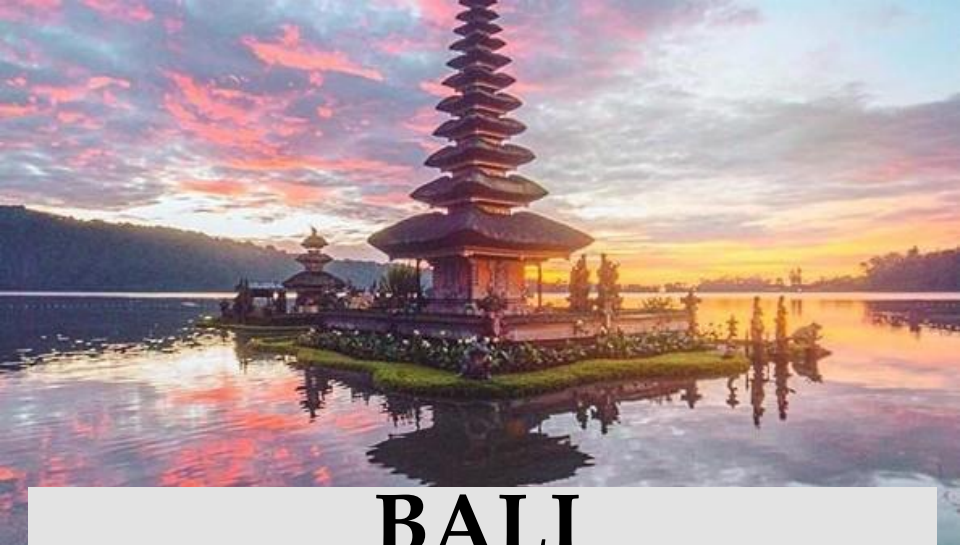
AUSTRIA

BALI

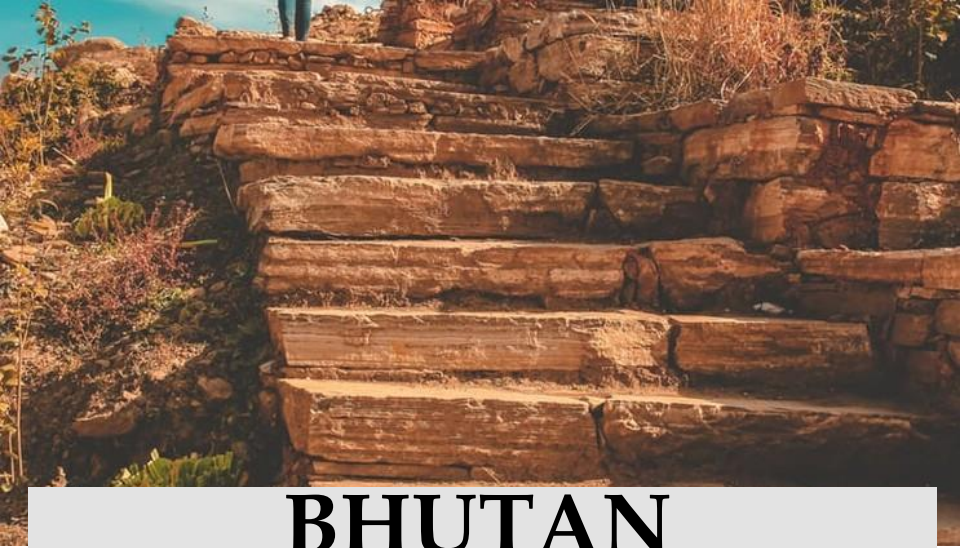

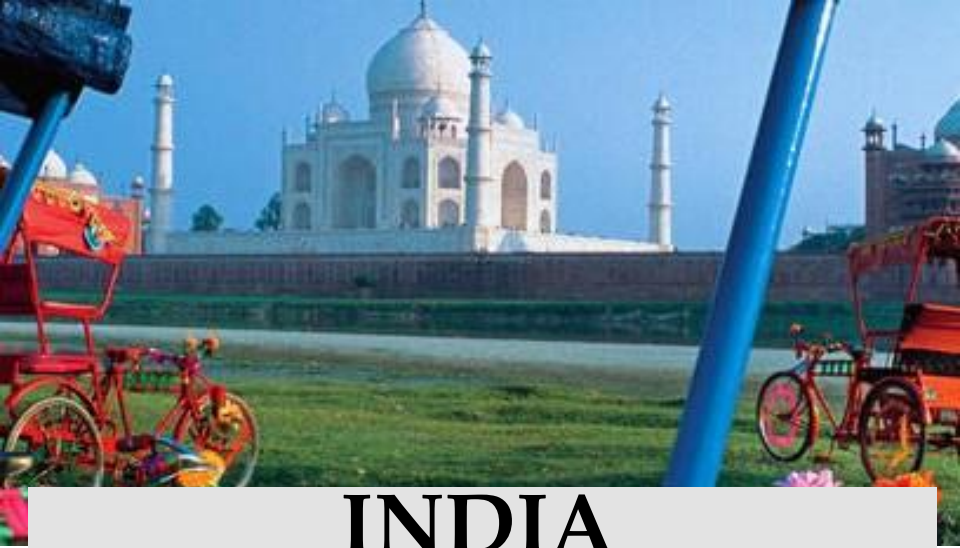

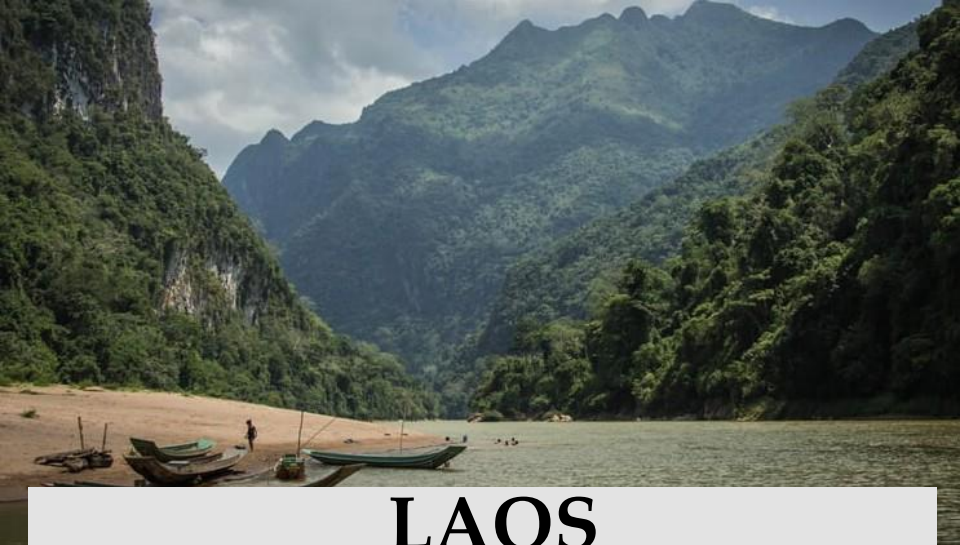

Take to the skies with a paragliding experience over the Malagasy landscapes and granite cliffs of Tsaranoro near Andanoka Village.

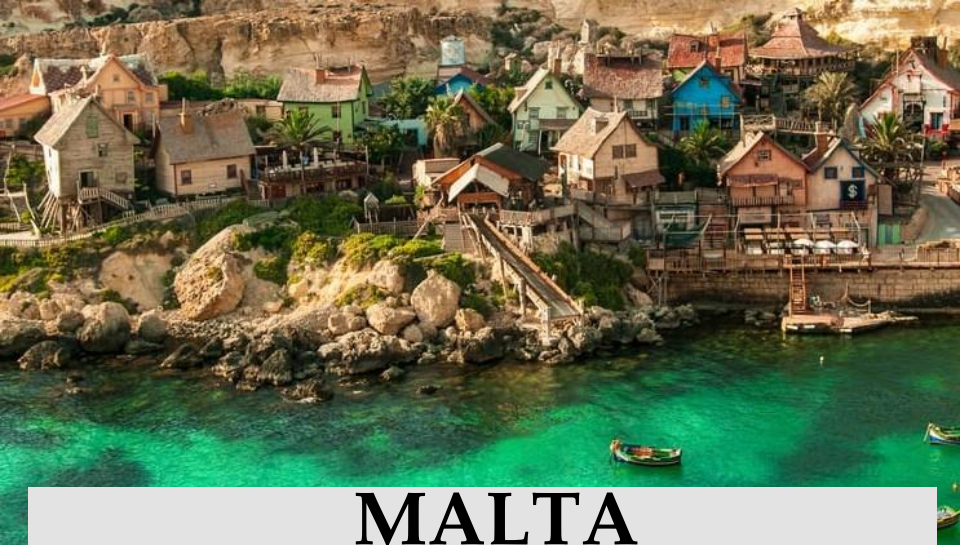

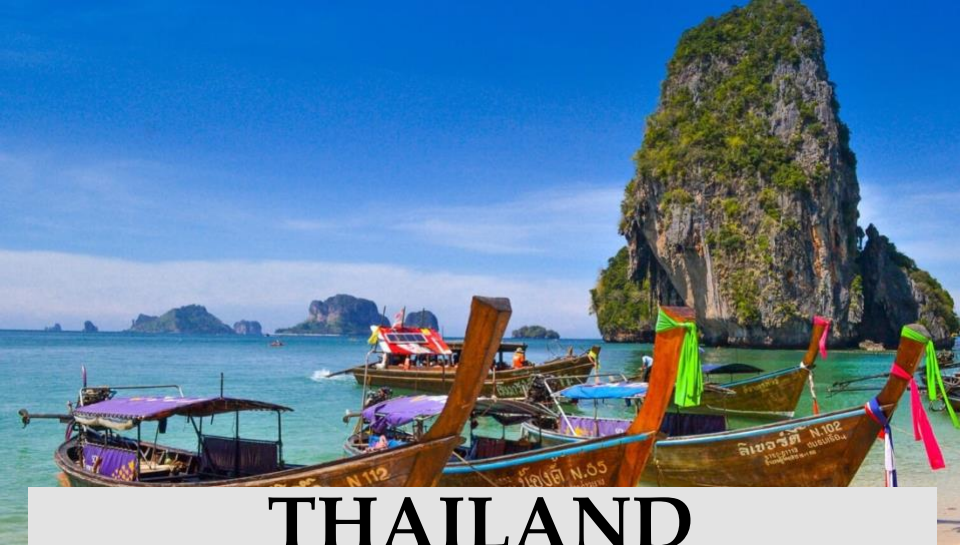

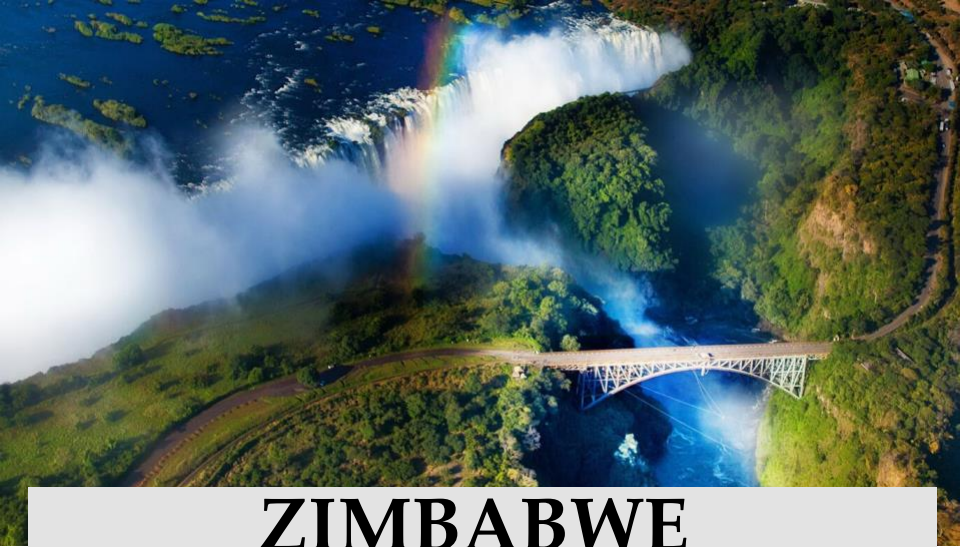
